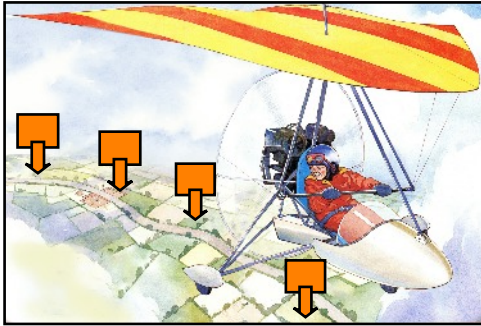


The Middle Ages: What happened when?
